Academic Content

Short-course delivered over the course of two weeks with 7 full day academic sessions, plus a one-day conference for participants to give short presentations on how the ideas covered in the modules may be applied in contexts that particularly interest them. LMH is responsible for all content and assessment for the Humanities Programme and is working in partnership with the Oxford International Study Abroad Programme on the content and assessment of the Science and Technology Programme.
