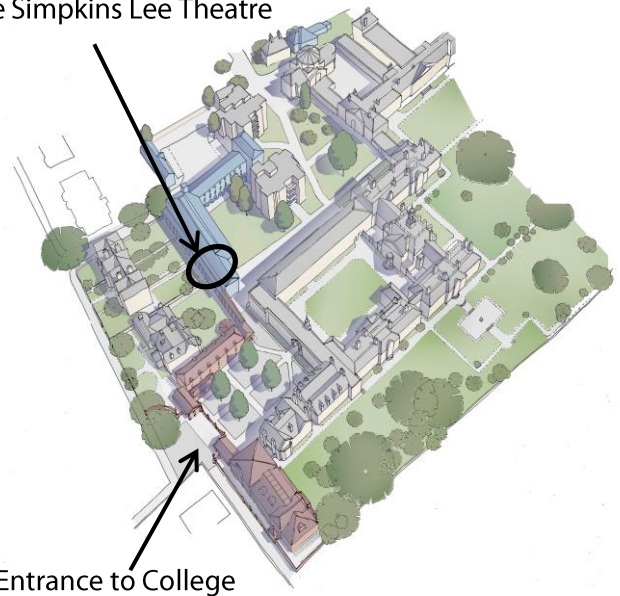


## The Simpkins Lee Theatre

The Simpkins Lee Theatre has been described as a 'little gem'. Built in 2010 with the character and detailing of an earlier era, it has the fully equipped tech booth of a modern theatre. A sweeping, decorative ceiling of carved wood provides dramatic flourish, in keeping with the neo-classical style of the surrounding Pipe Partridge building. The 150 seat, raked lecture theatre has a built in projection room with lighting and sound desks, and an integral AV system. Adjoining the theatre is a foyer area, which is ideal for registrations, and which links with the Monson Room, an attractive and sizeable function room.
